Overview

CARE Bangladesh's Strengthening the Dairy Value Chain (SDVC II) project is being implemented in 7 North-Western districts of Bangladesh comprising 26,138 farmers in 848 groups. Funded by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation the project is operating since 2013. The project has been working with a number of dairy value chain actors such as milk processing company, Livestock Health Workers (LHW), collection point managers, etc., for making dairy sector more structured and sustainable for the pro-poor farmers. The project introduced a digitalized process (Digital Fat Testing

system with the partnership of BRAC (one of the largest milk processing company of Bangladesh) through establishing 89 community based milk collection points and 22 chilling centers. Aiming to visualize it's all operations/ coverage




